PROCEDURES FOR YOUTH SCHOLARSHIP APPLICANT

1. All applications must be submitted on forms obtained from this foundation office, or Scholarship Committee Members. Computer forms will not be accepted unless in original format.
2. Applicants are eligible to apply only during the year of high school graduation.
3. Applicants must have completed high school with a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.00 (unweighted) on a scale of 4.00.
4. Applicants must be currently enrolled in their first year of advanced education.
5. Home school applications are eligible, but must submit SAT or ACT scores, and a letter of recommendation from a person outside the immediate family.
6. All applications must include a complete High School transcript, plus a transcript of an advanced education.
7. Scholarship proceeds may be used to further education at any accredited four (4) year college, two (2) year college, vocational, or technical school.
8. Scholarships will be paid to the individual upon receipt of confirmation of college enrollment.
9. No member of the immediate family of any NERCC Scholarship Committee member will be eligible for a scholarship.
10. All applications must be sent to the foundation office by August 31 of application year.
